ASSISTANT MASTER ELECTRICIAN (ME 2) job description.

The ME 2 Stage Technician will work with the Managing Executive Producer, Associate Producer and the Master Electrician as necessary on each event or production to oversee all lighting design, programming and system needs. He/she will ensure that all lighting fixtures are properly focused, and the lighting system is operational, and focus is maintained throughout the run of the show(s) or events. Previous experience as a lighting technician and front and rear projection equipment with proficient knowledge of electrical maintenance is required. This is a mid-entry level position. College graduate with a focus on theatrical lighting is preferred.

- Assist in any lighting aspects of the productions and installations with the ability to work smoothly, efficiently, and safely.
- Ability to work in a timely manner by adhering to the install/strike schedules executed by the Master Electrician and the design team.
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, and staff throughout The Wick Theatre, Museum Club and Costume World.
- Willingness to constantly listen and learn about daily operations from the Managing Executive Producer, and the Production Stage Manager.
- Assist the Master Electrician at production/staff meetings for The Wick Theatre and Costume World.
- Knowledgeable and skilled in the use of general hand and power tools and scissor lift.
- Strong knowledge of electricity.
- Must have ability to lift and carry over 50 pounds.
